2006-2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Tasting Notes- A Synopsis

2006

Pimrae Mt. Veeder, JJ Cohn Vineyard in Rutherford, Old Federal in Oakville, Spring Mountain, Meteor Vineyard (Coombsville) Napa. Juicy black cherry and raspberry notes from Rutherford dominate the aromas, as Spring Mountain's trademark purple plum, mocha, and sweet black olive notes add complexity. Coombsville offers a spicy note and its deep, inky-purple color. Drink now-2026

2007

Pimrae Mt. Veeder, Old Federal in Oakville, JJ Cohn in Rutherford, Spring Mountain slopes, and Blue Oak in Coombsville Napa.

Fully ripe Bing cherries, dark chocolate, vine-ripened blackberries, and a touch of vanilla and cedar. At entry, the wine is warm and very full-bodied, with flavors of warm, ripe purple fruits (boysenberries, blackberries) and a touch of warm cherry

juice. There is a hint of pipe tobacco toward the finish, and a slight suggestion of anise. Drink now - 2021

2008

Pimrae Mount Veeder, the Old Federal Vineyard in Oakville, the Varozza Vineyard in stony loam soils just north of Saint Helena, and from Spring Mountain District.

The aromas abound with blackberry, dark chocolate-covered cherries, a touch of anise, and a hint of vanilla/caramel. Its mountain origins (Spring Mountain and Mount Veeder) lend structural density to the mid-palate, while the benchland vineyards of Oakville and Saint Helena give a fresh berry juicy quality to the wine. Drink now - 2028

2009

Pimrae Mount Veeder, the Old Federal Vineyard in Oakville, the Varozza Vineyard in stony loam soils just north of Saint Helena, and from Spring Mountain District.

The aromas on this fully ripe Cabernet display mocha, black cherry, cola, anise, dusty plums, dried figs and a hint of toasty pecans. Intensely aromatic, the wine displays very ripe, luscious aromas. Drink now-2029

2010

Pimrae Mount Veeder, the Old Federal Vineyard in Oakville, Tietjen Vineyard in Rutherford, the Varozza Vineyard in stony loam soils just north of Saint Helena, and from Spring Mountain District.

Blueberries, blackberries, earthy coffee notes, and a touch of pipe tobacco dominates the aromas in this striking 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now - 2030
