## 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon

**VARIETAL COMPOSITION:**

100% Cabernet Sauvignon

**VINEYARDS:**

The fruit for this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon was harvested between October 9 and 23, from vineyards in Oakville, Mt. Veeder, Spring Mountain District and Saint Helena AVAs in the Napa Valley. The grape clusters were selectively hand-harvested, then each cluster was again inspected for perfection. The fruit from each vineyard location was fermented separately on skins for about 30 days, then gently pressed and transferred to new French oak barrels. This wine was bottled without fining or filtration in June, 2012.

**BARREL AGING:**

Fermented on skins for approximately three weeks then transferred to barrels (60% new French oak). The wine was aged in small oak for approximately 21 months.

**ANALYSIS:**

Alcohol: 14.8% by volume

**WINEMAKER NOTES:** tasted August 2013

Blueberries, blackberries, earthy coffee notes, and a touch of pipe tobacco dominates the aromas in this striking 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon. The interplay of sweet and savory notes entangle and evolve in the aromas as the wine opens and warms. On the palate, the texture of heavy satin creates an impression of warmth and ripeness, while the flavors replay the theme of complexity suggested by the aromas. As the earthy/mocha and more berry-driven flavors slowly fade, the lasting impression is of a very full-bodied, juicy, and velvety-textured Cabernet.”
